The main costs for attending are not tuition costs but living and extra expenses which is about 2/3rds of the total cost. The College does not offer on campus housing, but co-operates with local landlords to help provide affordable housing. A small number of jobs on the campus of GGWO & MBCS are reserved for International students to apply for. They are limited, not guaranteed and are prioritized towards leadership potential candidates. If offered, it will be part of a students' acceptance letter. Engaging in employment off campus is not permitted. Occasionally, church members in Baltimore open their homes to international students to live. We don't always accept those offers due to transportation needs among other reasons.

The costs associated with attending MBCS can be funded through the following:

1. Your Own Personal Funds: Please document accordingly.
2. Family or Housing Sponsor, Baltimore Based: If a family or someone you know has offered you housing.
3. Applying for On Campus Employment (*If accepted*)

The College estimates the student's average costs for an academic term of 9 months to be:
